Hinterlands is a national arts project led by the Canal & River Trust inviting artists and communities to explore canals as a creative space in five locations across England and Wales. Hinterlands Wales, a partnership between C&RT and arts organisation Peak, is focused around Pontypool on the Monmouthshire & Brecon Canal. Following a pilot in Spring/Summer 2018, the project includes two programme strands: *Ahoi! What Grows Here?* and *Performance Butty* and is taking place across two seasons in 2019-20.
